## THE MASS IS CHANGING - HOW AND WHY

Common questions asked about the new translation of the Latin texts of the Mass.

**Who prepared the new translation?** The initial work was done by the International Commission on English in Liturgy (ICEL), a body which serves the bishops' conferences of the countries that use English in the liturgy. These countries includes not only countries where English is the main language – such as England, the United States, Canada, Australia and Ireland – but also countries where English has a prominent liturgical role – such as India, Pakistan, the Philippines, Kenya and Bangladesh.

**How does the process work?** After ICEL completed drafts of different sections of the new translation, copies were circulated to the bishops' conferences for their input. After their input was incorporated, the bishops' conferences then approved the revised drafts and forwarded them to the Holy See for review by the Congregation for Divine Worship and the Discipline of the Sacraments.

This congregation, which is responsible for the final modification and approval of the texts, is assisted by an advisory group of English-speaking bishops known as the *Vox Clara* (Latin, "Clear Voice") committee.
