Genesis 18:20-32 Abraham bargained with God for the safety of the innocent.

Psalms 138 "Lord, on the day I called for help, you answered me.

THE MASS IS CHANGING - HOW AND WHY

Common questions asked about the new translation of the Latin texts of the Mass.

Why could a literal translation like this be confusing?

Hades is a Greek word that refers to the place of the dead-both good and bad-but it could be confusing to English-speakers, who may not be familiar with the word or who may think of it as hell, the place of the damned rather than of all the dead.

What would a dynamic equivalent be?

The Bible translators of the *Revised Standard Version: Catholic Edition* avoided the phrase "gates of *hades*" and used "powers of death" instead. This was a dynamic translation because it tried to convey the same thought in a way that did not reflect the actual wording of the original.
